JOB SUMMARY:

16. Maintains and promotes own personal professional growth.
17. Performs other related duties as required.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must favorably pass the Washington State Patrol/FBI background check.
- Demonstrate mature behavior and ability to use sound judgment.
- Recognizes all children as learners.
- Must submit a complete application packet.
